

# **Synopsis**

This is an excellent compilation of communization theory by Benjamin Noys. It gives a fresh overview of the theory, potential, and shortcomings of this new field of theory from the radical Left. The primary purpose of communization is to overcome the shortcomings of the transitionary-state model of achieving communism that was on the center stage during the 20th century, and to conceive of communism as the very process of revolution itself, rather than the end goal or as a program to be implemented after the seizure of the state. The book itself has essays and articles from a variety of people from around the West. The writing can be excessively dense and esoteric, especially in works by Theorie Communiste (TC), which is compounded by the fact that their work is being translated from French. Nonetheless, it is worth the extra effort to muddle through their indirect form of presentation, and is useful for stimulating tangential lines of thought. Overall, the book does a very good job at persuasively putting forth a critique of traditional socialism and revolutionary communism, as well as providing an actual alternative and vision to a better future.
