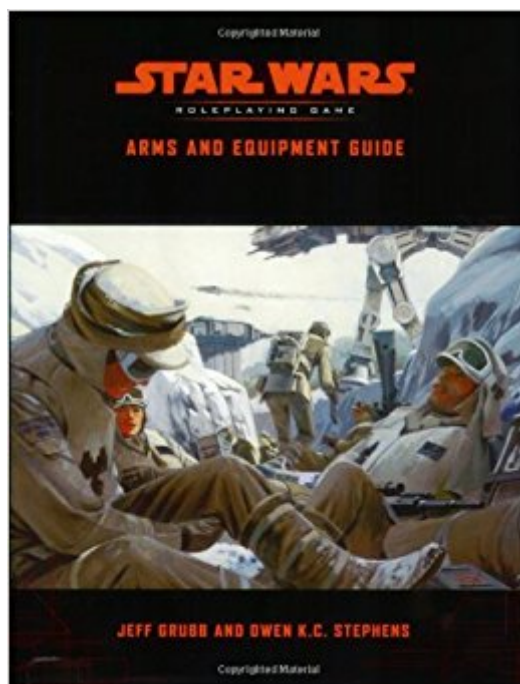

For those SWRPG players who want a good selection of standard and alternative equipment, this is the first and most valuable guide to get. Personal arms, armor, common droids, personal vehicles, equipment for hostile environments, sensors, medical gear, security gear, tool kits, and more. It includes descriptions of the equipment, legality of that equipment, rules for modifying or jurying rigging, and so on.

I am a huge fan of the Star Wars RPG and I collect all the associated books - from the core books to the supplements. While many are of course optional, this is one of the ones I think every Star Wars RPG'er would really enjoy having in their collection of reference books. Not a major complaint, and some readers might not even care. As far as game mechanics, there are tons of weapon options for flamers, disintegrators, sith weapons, as well as droids. A great accessory any player or GM can use.

This is a very useful volume filled with lots of information and ideas for gear. My GM has already used it to modify some of the ships in our game with information from the book.
