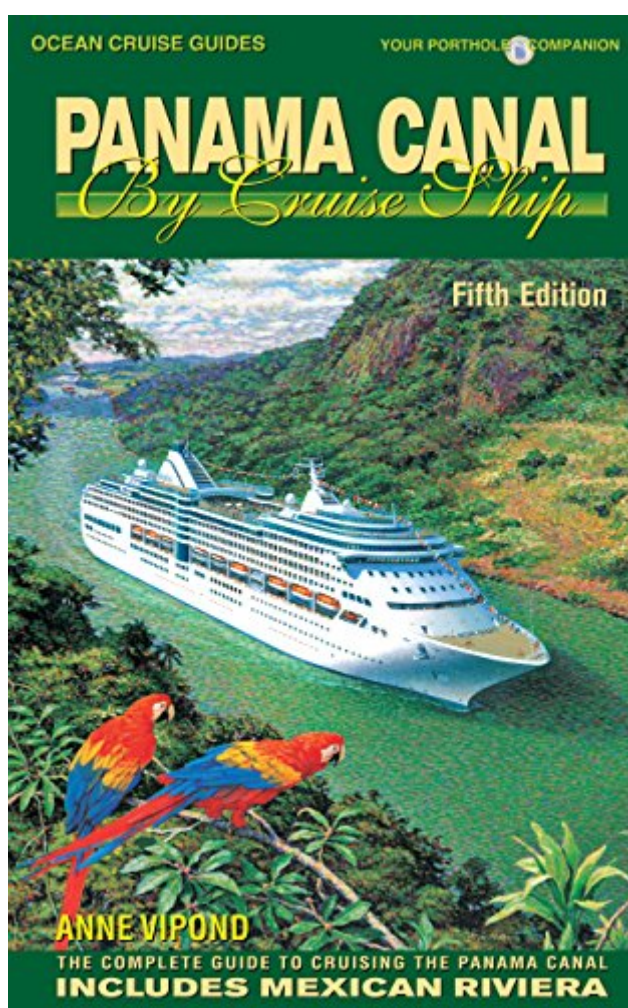

I bought this book to replace the 2006 edition I used on my first transit of the canal. There was a significant amount of updating between the two editions. All the photos and maps are now in color, information about the new canal and Panama Canal Railway passenger service has been added, along with revised details on the cruise lines that serve Panama. I have several books on the

building and history of the canal, but this was the only book I needed to prepare for and take on my Panama cruise. The book tells you what to take, what to expect, what to look for and what to avoid. I especially liked the descriptions of the various ports ships visit during a Panama Canal cruise and recommendations for things to do while ashore.

Shopped every book about the Panama Canal before going on a cruise through the Canal. This is the best overall, portable book around. Noticed the cruise line also featured it. History of the Canal is excellent. Descriptions of Central America countries are brief--but that's not the topic of the book. Get it for the Canal.
