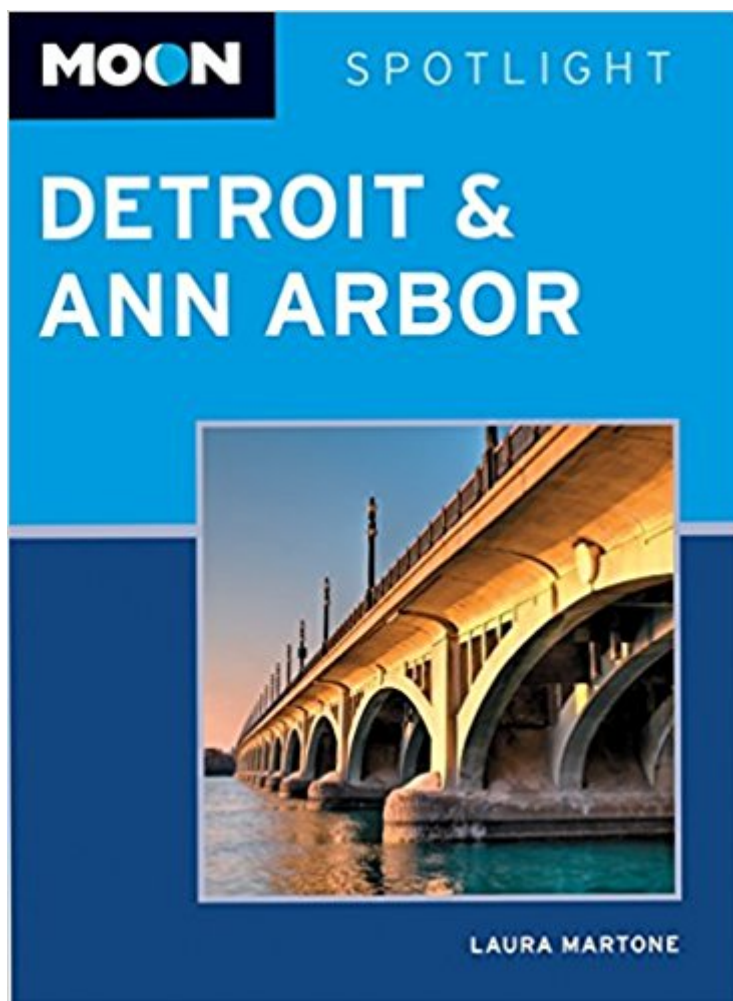

Laura Martone has been an avid traveler since childhood. While growing up, she and her mother would often take long road trips to fascinating US landmarks, such as the Rocky Mountains and Monticello. After graduating from Northwestern University in 1998 with a dual degree in English and radio/TV/film, Laura continued to explore the United States with her husband, Daniel. Equally fond of cultural and natural wonders, she has a particular affinity for the state of Michigan, where she spends her summers. Laura first traveled to the Great Lakes State in 2000 to visit her husband's family and has experienced a lot of this diverse locale ever since. She's searched for Petoskey stones along the shores of Lake Superior, picked wild blueberries in the woods of the Lower Peninsula, toured an active GM truck plant in the Flint area, explored the art

galleries of Saugatuck and Douglas, and attended the National Cherry Festival in Traverse City; and she's not done yet. I bought this considering a move to Detroit. It has been insightful and helpful. I don't know if I will make the move, but I certainly would like to visit the city. Against so much bad press, the city still stands with all manner of rich architecture and story.

The book was useful, but brief on Detroit (probably with good reason) and more extensive on Ann Arbor. On our visit, we decided to take a tour called "Show Me Detroit". The tour was outstanding, and a better way to see Detroit than trying to DIY.
