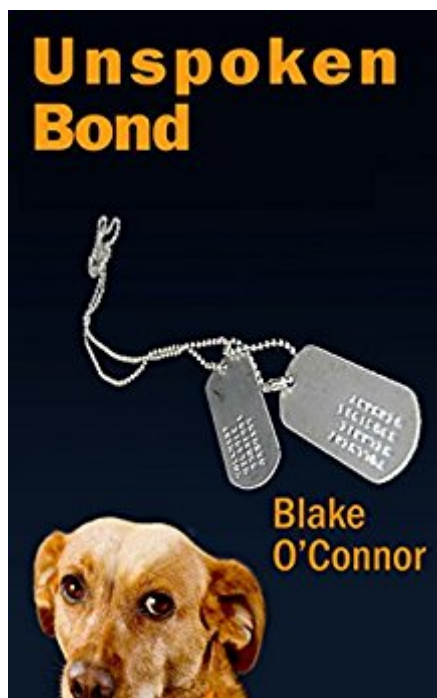

It reminded me of another superb book about a dog and a human, One Good Dog by Susan Wilson. These two books are similar in some ways and both are great stories. I liked the caring for Joe expressed in this book and the author's belief that dogs have souls. I completely agree. Can't judge a book by its cover -- still true. I expected more of a dog story, but the book was more about the character David Hess and how his life was impacted by an abandoned dog. The dog was pivotal to the story however. I was pleasantly surprised that this was not a "tear jerker" as many dog stories are. A quick, enjoyable read. The story was a little predictable, as were the character personalities. Unspoken Bond is mostly about how the presence of a special dog influenced situations rather than being a story with a dog as the central character. I especially liked the first part of the book that was written mostly through the dog's perspective. The writing is 'clean cut' meaning that it is an appropriate read for nearly any adult. I've already recommended it to a book club of modest, elderly readers. I'm sure they will like it.
