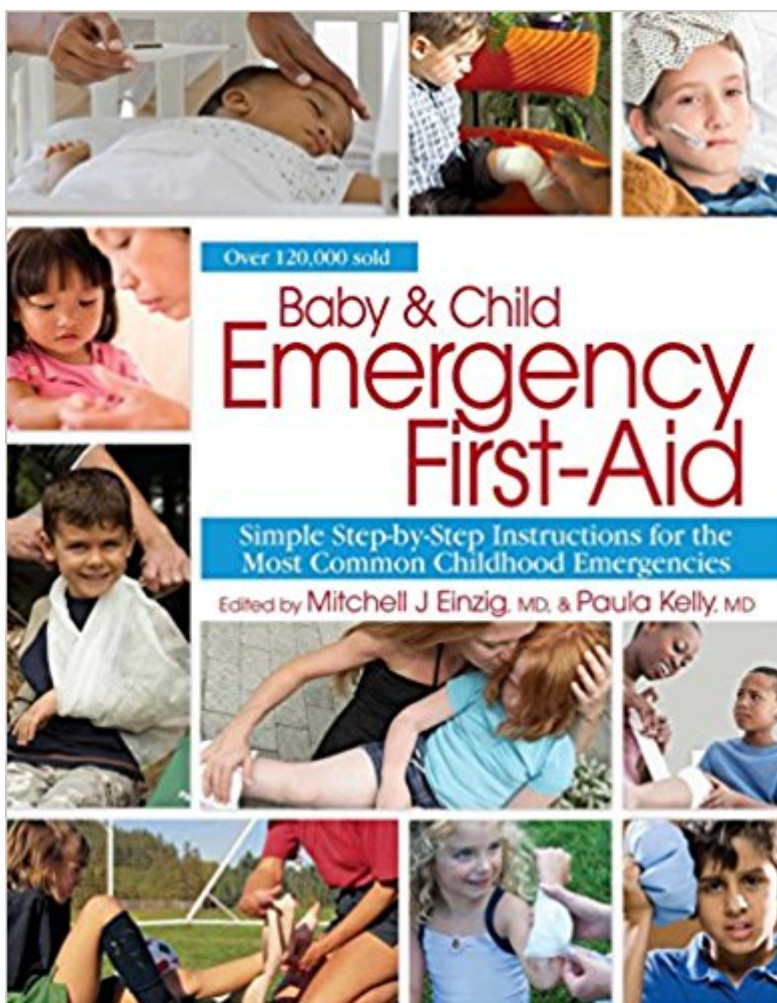

I hope they never have to use the book, but there is security in knowing you have help in the event something happens. One other suggestion...this might be a good item to gift one's own child who is a babysitter. In the past I've taught classes at the YWCA for potential sitters (ages 12 on up) & they were very popular & those capable girls posed many excellent questions.

I like this book and find it very helpful. I keep it nearby and browse through it every so often to help remind me of what to do in an emergency. The instructions for each emergency are very detailed and have pictures, which is helpful. It is a small, thin book, so easy to find what you are looking for. Also helpful if you are wanting to trace with the book, because it is small and thin. With a toddler and an infant, I definitely recommend to parents or anybody with little ones around.

Update for my daughter

This is a good book to have if you have children around the house or for a day care. However, it does not replace a First Aid class. As a U.S. Army Doc, there is more you can learn and just having the book will not help you in an emergency. Read it, Know it, Practice it.
