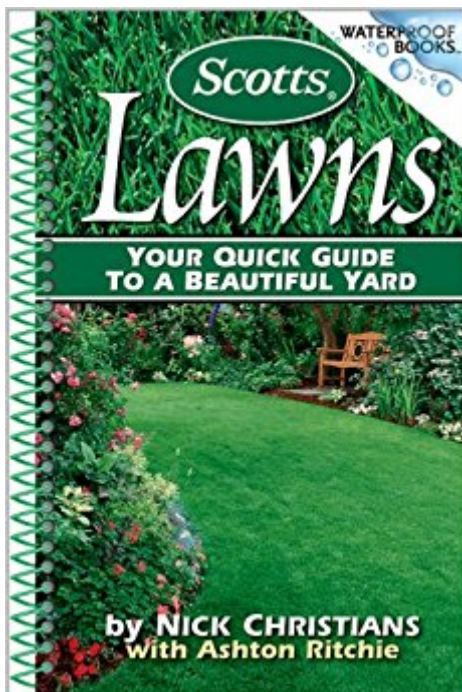

If you want to be able to tell kentucky bluegrass from a tall fescue there are no pictures to show you how to identify the different grasses. Otherwise you can learn a lot from this small but dense guide.

This book was highly recommended when I was looking around. Came spiral bound and the pages are waterproof (big plus as you'll want to use it while you're walking around outside to identify things). He's learned a bit from it and would recommend it himself.

I've learned a lot about lawns since having to care for one for two years now with my new house. I've picked up tips from neighbors, read things on the internet when I had questions, etc. But this book was able to not only teach me more than I thought I'd learn from it, but it also proves to be a great, easy-to-read point of reference. The best part about the book is the detailed pictures of weeds, diseases, and the effects pest can have on your lawn. These things can be difficult to identify, and pictures on the internet are usually hit or miss. Once you have identified the problem in your lawn, the book explains how to deal with it. The book covers everything from how to mow, how and when to properly fertilize, how and when to seed, proper watering techniques, even finishing touches like string trimming and edging; this book has everything you need to make a perfect lawn. It's also very helpful for the less obsessed lawn owners, there are different lawn care programs for different levels of dedication ranging from some simple mowing tips and a once a year fertilizing, to a stringent schedule of up to five fertilization and a fully manicured lawn. There's different advice for different regions as well. If you care about your lawn, get this book. Even if you think you're an expert on the subject, it's great as a point of reference.

Several pages were stuck together but with gentle persuasion they separated without tearing. I expected the book to be larger 4" x 8". Otherwise this is a very helpful and easy to read book to learn how to improve our lawn.

It will help you take care of your lawn in ways you may not have known it is a starter book for dummies it is well written, there are more informative books out there but use this as a base and then go from there. This book provides a good summary of lawn maintenance for beginners like me. I'm quite satisfied with this. I wish, however, it described more on lawn maintenance in transition zones. For example, I wanted to learn more on mowing / feeding frequency (especially in winter when a cool season grass

takes over the warm season grass), how to overseed, what warm and cool season grasses are the best match in a transition zone etc. I live in Triangle area in North Carolina.
