

I didn't like Gervase as a hero. He is portrayed as the affable, kind Frenchman but hated Wulfric. His personality came across very shallow. There is a little bit of a plot with the war going on and with Alleyne Bedwyn missing and presumed dead.

I tend to mix up who is the shining star of each of this series because I pick up the next book as

soon as I finish the book I've read. Morgan is a funny young woman who has a lot of spunk. I enjoyed the storyline.

ALL books by Mary Balogh are a treat and a lovely indulgence. I positively adore Mary Balogh's use of the suspension points and exclamatives to convey much more than what is written. I loved this particular plot and the way it is written. The two protagonists are interesting and their characters multifaceted. The other Bedwin siblings and their spouses participate in the event and it is a pleasure to meet them again in this book.

I have found that all the novel in the "Slightly" series are a good read. I do suggest that one read them in order. There are many references to the previous novel that reading them in order makes more sense. But they can be read as a stand alone novel.

I have only recently discovered Mary Balogh and have come to really love her books. Her characters and stories are vivid and not the least bit contrite. This particular series is very good. Once I read one book about one of the members of this family, I wanted to know ALL the members of the family. I'm still reading her books right now and as soon as I am finished with a series I want to find more.

The Bedwyn that is always playing is well played by the heroine. While neither hero nor heroine is honest at first, they manage to involve each other in playing at being someone other than what they are. It's not confusing, it's Mary Balogh at her finest, putting her characters into spots they don't want to be in, and giving them every opportunity to rethink their plans.

Balogh and t he Bedwyns what more is there to say each is as unique as an individual and a member of a fascinating family in a facinating time in history. And a lesson that sometimes you get
