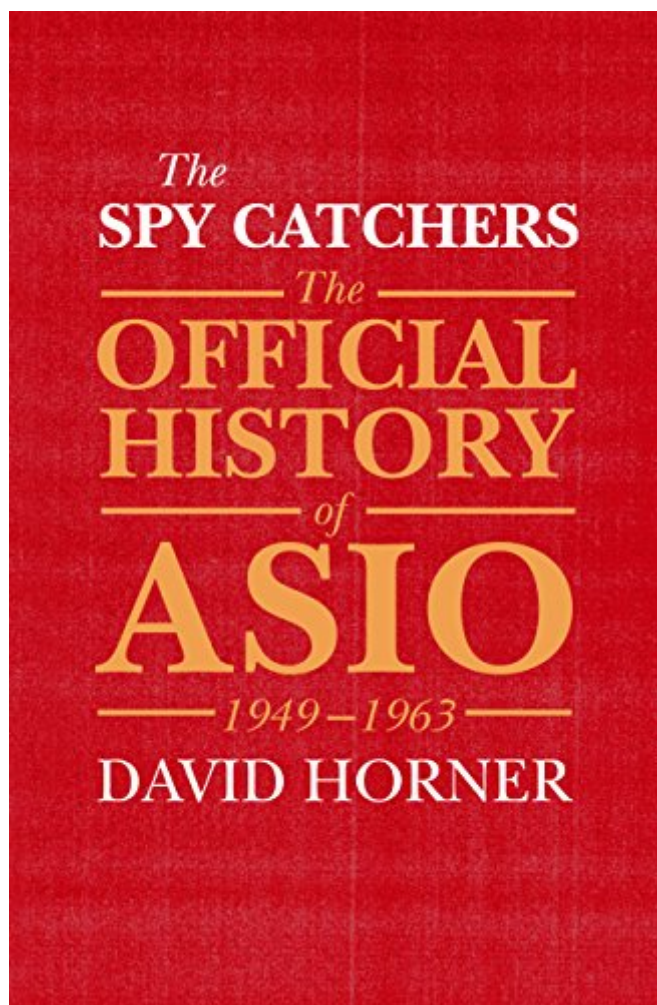

I was a bit disappointed in this book. It tells the story of ASIO from a bureaucratic point of view I thought. Stopping at 1963 of course misses the role of ASIO during the war in Vietnam, which I felt was devious and more directed by their anti-communist fervour...and that of their political masters. The later conflict between ASIO and the ALP and Lionel Murphy is worth a detailed analysis. Most of what Horner reveals is known, but it is put together well. I would have liked the book to go for another 15 years or so, and a closer look at the ASIO operations in those years too.
