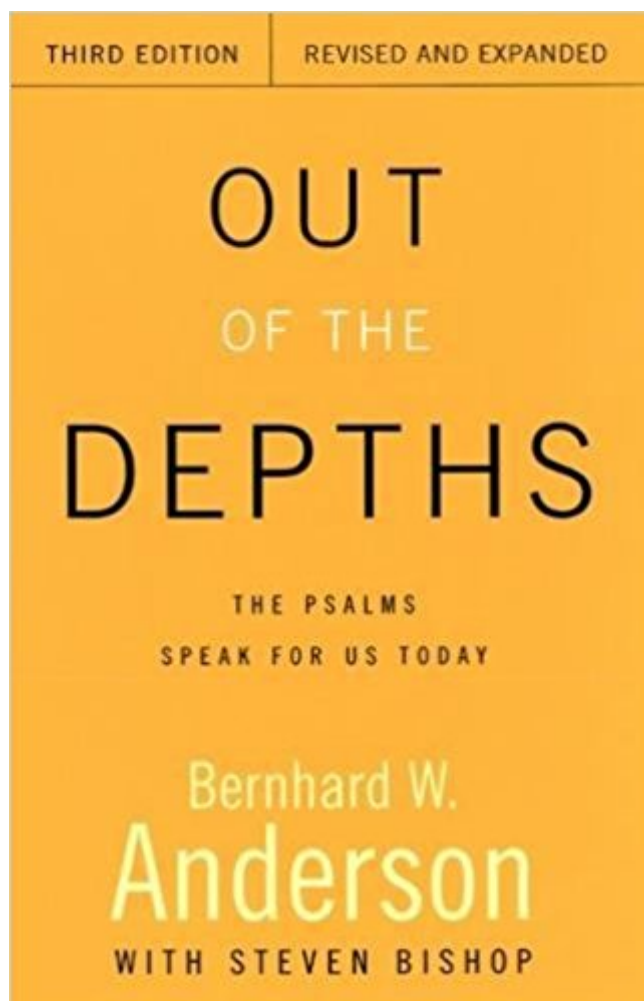

A noted educator, author, and biblical scholar, Anderson is perhaps best known for his textbook, *Understanding the Old Testament*, which set records in sales for a book in that field and is read in translation around the world.
