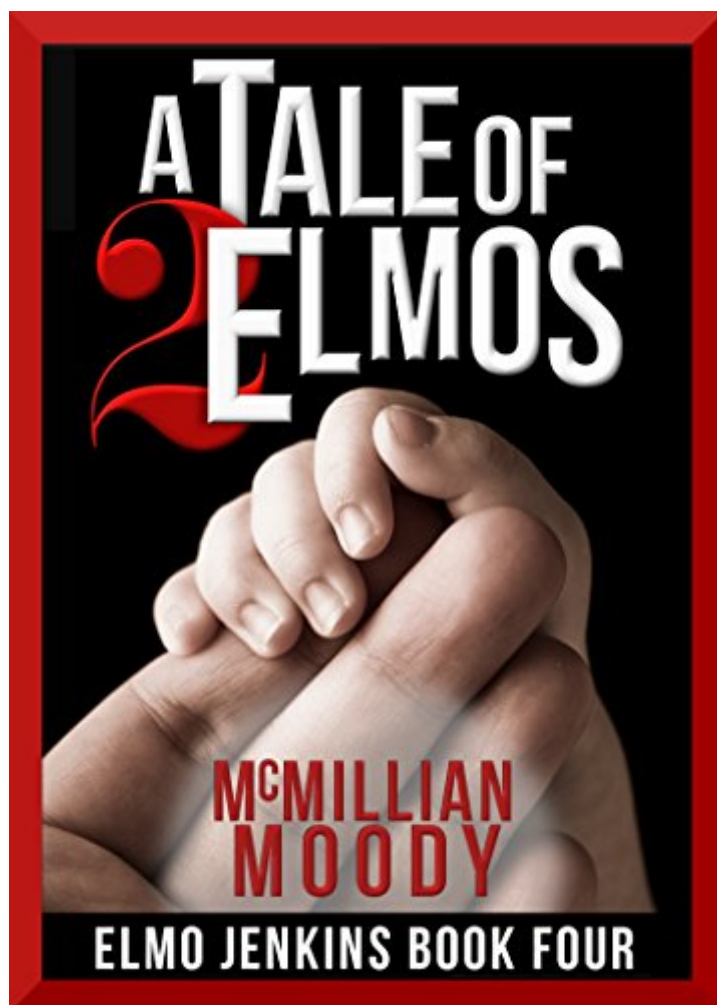

forgiveness by confessing their wrongdoing & truly repenting...so indirectly, it's about asking what's cluttering our lives & getting in the way of being all God wants us to be. It shows how God leads us, through the everyday moments of life, to a place where we can draw closer to Him, but never does He force us. Obedience is an act of will, but ultimately, if God forced our obedience, we'd be nothing but automatons. It spans the spectrum of church life, from young to old, poor to rich, & emphasizes the one thing we all have in common: God's grace, the grace that takes us from fear to courage, hate to love, old life to New Life, & urges us to tell others about Him, to be joyful about Him regardless of circumstances. Serious yet light-hearted, you'll enjoy this continuing saga of Elmo.

After having read 2 other books in this series of laugh out loud events in the life of Elmo Jenkins, I heartily encourage all to read these books. Highly entertaining they are at once thought provoking and inspirational. Elmo is everywhere and we all know an "ELMO". Enjoy watching him mature and come into his own. Recommended for all adult readers and some young adult readers. McMillan Moody, please continue this series for me! I have passed along my copies to others who I believe need to believe in themselves.
