

Mason City, Iowa, became home to his City National Bank and Park Innï¿ the last surviving Wright hotel. In addition, his prototype Stockman House helped launch the Prairie School architectural style. Soon after, architect Walter Burley Griffin followed in Wrightï¿ s footsteps, designing a cluster of Prairie School homes in the Rock Crest/Rock Glen neighborhood. Design historian Roy Behrens leads the way through Mason Cityï¿ s historic development from the Industrial Revolution to the modern era of Frank Lloyd Wright.
