

What it means for Christ to be in the believer and 3. How God is faithful to deal with the old man (Jacob) in all His children. This was a very liberating book for me.

Nee has a way of delivering the depth of God's word with a simplicity that can only come from personal experience. Reading this teaching will drive you to want to begin once more to explore God's message to us delivered through the lives and experiences of three great men in the Old Testament.
