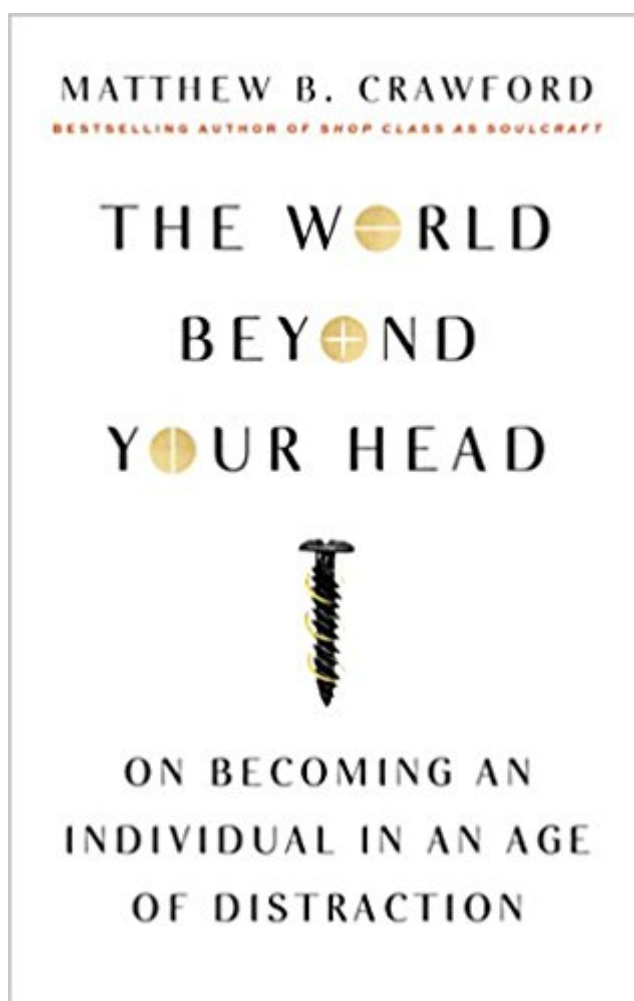

He shows that our current crisis of attention is only superficially the result of digital technology, and becomes more comprehensible when understood as the coming to fruition of certain assumptions at the root of Western culture that are profoundly at odds with human nature. *The World Beyond Your Head* makes sense of an astonishing array of common experience, from the frustrations of airport security to the rise of the hipster. With implications for the way we raise our children, the design of public spaces, and democracy itself, this is a book of urgent relevance to contemporary life.

Very stimulating reading, with challenging ideas that rocked my conceptions about learning. The proposal for an attention commons is relevant, as we are more and more solicited by all kinds of interest groups despite ourselves. However, I felt left down by the modesty of the recommendations at the end of the book, which were not proportioned to the magnitude of the indictment. A comment of secondary importance: the chapter on the construction and repair of organs in Virginia was very detailed, and although not without interest, too long in relation to the substantial previous parts of the book.

Lonergan posed the question "How can the mind become conscious of its own bias when that bias springs communal flight from understanding which is supported by the whole texture of our civilisation?" This book points to a way out by heightening our awareness of our epistemic system without being technically tedious and obtuse. In penetrating the meaning of things it never loses contact with common sense, an amazing achievement.

This book will really made an impact on me and makes you think about modern media and the pervasive impact of the internet, and particularly cellphones, on your attention and your time. Really increases your awareness of the interruptions we allow our world to make to us. Very interesting and compelling. I have been sharing with all my friends and family. I strongly encourage you to read or listen to the book - it is awesome brain food.

Crawford went beyond his first book to make a thought provoking statement about the state our cultural transformation and how participation in a community of craftsman and its ideals of excellence can be beneficial to our unity as a people.

Insightful, makes you think - and brush up on your vocabulary!
