

This is a fine example of the old school of museum scientific publications -- the book is clearly intended for the general public, but it doesn't sacrifice scientific rigor for popularization. Clear and well-reproduced scientific illustrations of all the major fossil critters, plus informed commentary. A good guide to La Brea, even now.Chester Stock (1892-1950) was professor of paleontology at the California Institute of Technology. As a young man he worked at the UC excavations at La Brea, He became world-renowned for his studies of the California Pleistocene, and was long-associated with the Hancock Park diggings.From the County Museum copy in front of me:First edition 19303rd ed. 19466th ed.1956, 6th printing 1968.Note that, as for most OOP books, this one is for sale on
