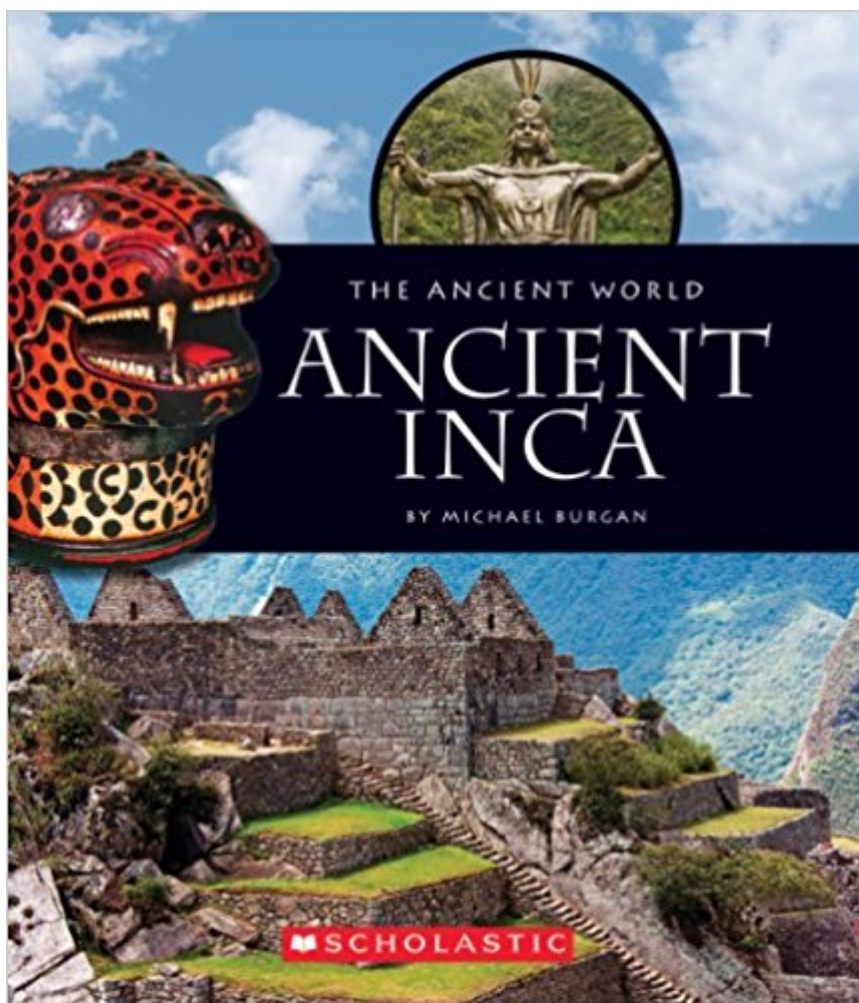

This book brings the Incan empire to life through breathtaking photographs. It offers large chunks in sidebars for context, and it gives historical and cultural information. The book is a very nice size, 8" X 9", so the large color photographs and illustrations really jump out. Great book -- good information. Does not explore the possibility of Incan culture proceeding from Asian colonists along the Pacific coast, but it does present the Wari people and the Chimu ruins. Interested children can follow up on those leads.
