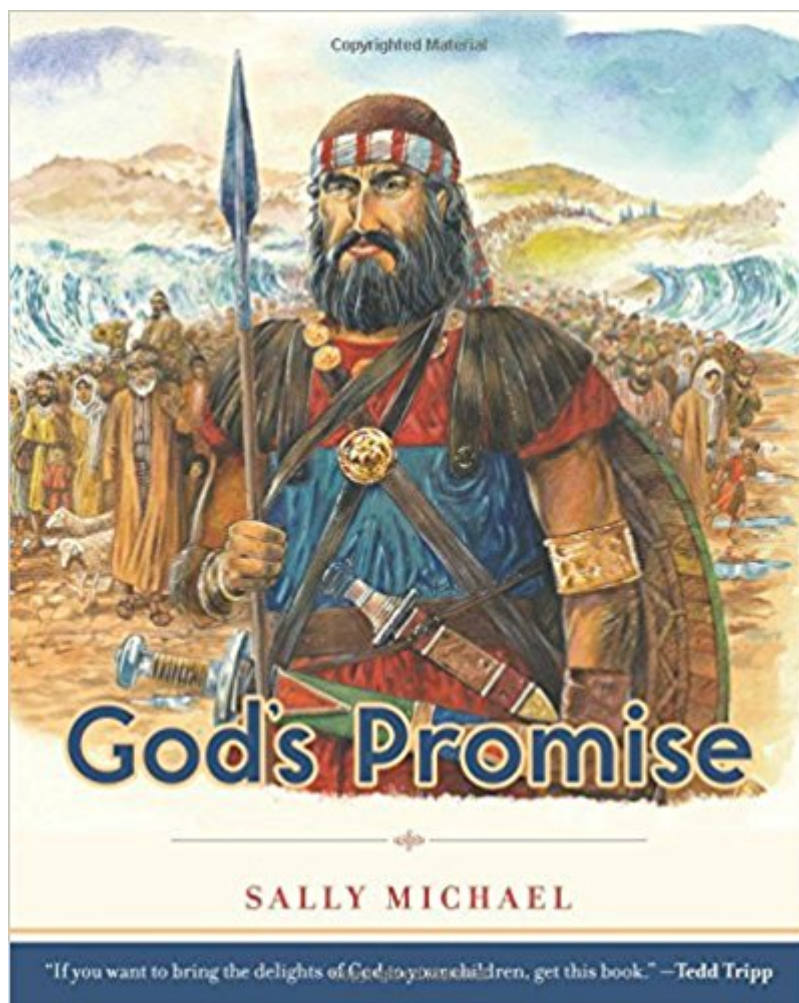

Sally Michael is the co-founder and publishing consultant of Children Desiring God, and she developed their widely used Sunday school curriculum for young people. She is also an author and a speaker, and she served as Minister for Children at Bethlehem Baptist Church in Minneapolis, Minnesota, for sixteen years.

This book, along with its companion book "The Names of God", is one of my favorite Bible Study books/devotionals to use with my children. This book is probably intended for 2nd to 6th grade or so. I am using it with younger children though. It is written very well. It asks questions and gives a bible story and real life example of the "promise" covered. There are also additional activity suggestions at the end of each lesson. For example there are one to two verses at the end of each lessons that you can write on an index card for memory work and add to your "God's promises" box (wrapped like a present, because God's promises are like gifts!). It begins with "Salvation" promises, and covers promises for believers and unbelievers. I feel that it is not at all watered down, but gives a very strong foundational understanding to children. I actually get a blessing out of reading it as well! Look for "Names of God" by the same author! We love that one too!

I purchased this book to enjoy with my little six year boy during our morning reading time. What I had not expected was how much it would minister to me in this particular season of my life. This little book is so rich in the abundance of His blessings, it is a delight for all ages and leads to the most marvelous conversations with your children. I highly recommend this book, in fact, when we were finished both my boy and I were rather disappointed that it was over, my boy's answer to that? "Mommy, let's read it again!". You bet, that's just what we plan to do.

I teach the 1st/2nd grade Sunday School class at my church and use a curriculum from Children Desiring God (www.childrendesiringgod.org) called "Faithful to All His Promises" which thoroughly explores the promises God makes to His people throughout the Bible. It is a wonderful study for the age group with a very solid biblical context. I give this book (God's Promise) to my kids as a gift when they graduate from my class because I feel like it is a wonderful keepsake and reminder of all that we have learned together during our time together. It is a wonderful companion to the curriculum!

I have been using this book with my four children, and we have all loved it! I had no idea that it was going to be a book that I would love as much as they do...and learn from. I have recommended it to my mom, adult friends, and anyone that teaches or has children. The author explains every promise in such a way that they are easy to understand, and then she backs it up with Scripture. I heartily recommend this book!!!

Written for children, this book is so full of God's truths, that I tweaked it a bit and made lesson plans for young adults. I am enjoying learning from it as well. Scripture is used to teach in a way that you may not have really pondered over before in learning Who God is as He says in Scripture, as opposed to who we conjure Him up to be in our own minds. Great truths!

This series of books has been apart of my morning devotions with my 9 year old for sometime now. The chapters are short enough to read through before my daughter heads off to school, and the way it is written is easily understood by even my 5 year old. Sally Michael is spot on with her theology. My daughter and I both enjoy these books, and look forward to more books by this author.
