

Like most of the Field Guide series, this one covers the ins and outs of the Nikon Creative Lighting System in its most current iterations. However, there was minimal information about legacy equipment (SB-600, SB-800) and NO information about the capabilities of older camera bodies with either legacy or new equipment. I have a D300 and a D200 with two SB-600s, an SB-800 and a new used SB-900 and I learned nothing about how to make them all play nicely together, except that I need to drop another \$700 for Pocket Wizard triggers. If I were from Nikon, I wouldn't be happy at the author's litany of all the additional equipment necessary to make the CLS do its job....

Book has lots of useful info for using your Nikon Speedlights. The third edition focuses on the newer 700 and 900 strobes. If you have 600s and 800s, you'll really want the Second Edition. Both books will get you up to speed on how to best use your speedlights in both the field and studio.

I bought this book and also the Speedlight Handbook by Stephanie Zeiti. Both are very helpful for getting the most out of using an attachable flash gun. I'm the 85 year old "serious amateur" that reviewed the speed light. Of the two gooks, I think I'd give 5 stars to the Zetti book, but they are different enough that both were useful for me to read (and then reread when you are puzzled about something specific). Books like these are way more helpful than the manuals that come with the equipment.
