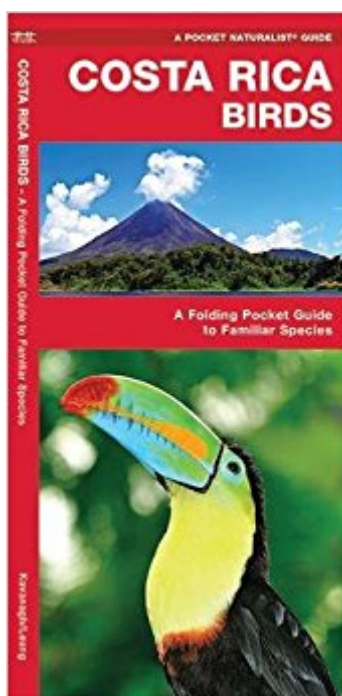

While you won't want to discard your bulky bird, flower, tree, etc. books, these are ideal casual identification guides. In addition to the illustrations, there is enough descriptive material on each species to key in on and then follow-up when it is convenient to scour the books for greater details and confirmation. Very useful easy guide to the birds of Costa Rica. Compact so doesn't take up much space. I was hoping to find a bird with a very long yellow tail in the guide which I had seen by Lake Arenal but didn't find it in this guide. The guide is fine for the casual bird watcher but I think a serious birder might need a more comprehensive guide and have to carry a big book or kindle. It is well produced and easy to use.

This product is great for what it is designed to do, many of the common birds and the size to fit in the pocket. The only element of improvement would be to add a couple of more folds with more birds.

It is like new, very well made, water proof and strong, and perfect for my grandchildren's trip soon. The Guide covers enough birds for them to stay interested. Buy it here if interested. Guides like these will be a lot more money in Costa Rica, where I lived for many years in the very popular tourist area of La Fortuna. This small, laminated, fold-up pamphlet looks perfect for what it is intended for--an introduction. While it probably won't show me everything I want to know, for my purposes on nature walks, it should do what I want it to do, especially if I get additional lectures from the birder!

I had another foldout pocket guide that included fish, reptiles, amphibians and mammals as well as birds. I got this one so that I would have a more complete guide for the birds. It did list more birds, but left out some of the major species in Costa Rica. It was disappointing.
