This is one amazing book. The illustrations alone are worth the price. The narrative is packed with

information on all aspects of the LZ-129 'Hindenburg'. What's more, the text is not dry as dust. Plenty of human interest in this book. Of special interest is the section on why the fire happened. The authors debunk the "rocket fuel" cover myth, and the myth that it wasn't the hydrogen. Sadly, I must agree with the authors: the accident happened due to careless risk-taking on the part of 3 of the most experienced airship commanders in history. I own 4 other books on this marvelous airship, but this one takes the cake. If you love airships, and are fascinated with the 'Hindenburg', then you need this book in your library. It's the best one out there.

This is a first-rate book as would be expected from the three joint authors. It is extremely well written and sticks to the facts, something that has been badly lacking in this subject matter. You also know those facts are correct! It is also beautiful to look at and contains a number of rare photos. If you only have one book on the Hindenburg, this needs to be it.

This is an exceptional publication. It includes an amazing collection of photographs from the time of construction to destruction, printed on high quality paper. Also, there is an incredible collection of colour photographs of the passenger state rooms and accommodation areas. The accompanying script is well written. In my opinion, for anyone interested in this era it would be essential reading.
