What a lovely, sweet romance! When Libby and Luke step away from city life in San Francisco and move to the seaside town of Bodega so that Luke can pursue his dream of becoming a commercial fisherman, the results are compelling and tragic. There are many twists and turns as the story unfolds. Ultimately though, this is a story of new beginnings and the healing power of love. What I enjoyed most about the book was Ms. White's attention to detail. I really felt like I was in Libby's body, seeing, smelling, feeling and tasting life in Bodega. I was really captured by Libby's journey, and the book kept me turning pages well into the night. Great read!

Let me first say this: sometimes it is just refreshing to dive into a gentle read. Don't get me wrong...there is a time and a place for edge-of-your-seat entertainment, but sometimes you just want to take the time to breathe along with the characters whose lives you are inhabiting for a time. Such is the case with *The Salty Dog*. Author Debbie White has created such a sweet story. Our heroine, Libby, is successful, well-loved, and very much "together," but she unexpectedly finds herself in a situation which makes it impossible for her to carry on with life as she has known it. It's equally impossible for her to truly begin again. The easy analysis would be to say that Libby does begin anew, but I don't believe that's the case - and for me that explains a great deal about the book's charm. Libby is not an immature young thing trying to "find herself." She is a grown woman with responsibilities, relationships, and commitments. She has known true love and it has shaped her. The easy thing to do, when her life is turned upside down, would be to run away, and many authors may have taken the easy way out and sent Libby down that path. Debbie White didn't take the easy path. She took the honest, realistic, relatable path, and that makes *The Salty Dog* irresistible. To "begin again" would be to deny the power of the past, so instead Libby just keeps on going. This book is an incredibly easy, fast read. Take the time to get to know Libby, and breathe along with her.

I'm a sucker for starting-over love stories that leave me rooting for the heroine to get back on her feet. And I'm a fan of characters that start businesses, in this case *The Seaside Cafe*. Oh, and I love stories where you can't guess who the heroine will ultimately choose. Will still-grieving Libby decide on mysterious Marshall or successful Jackson? She makes some impulsive decisions before making the right one. This book is a romance, not a dog story, although

Libby owns a dog. The Salty Dog is a boat and, as the story unfolded, the author brought me full circle to understand the importance of the boat!
