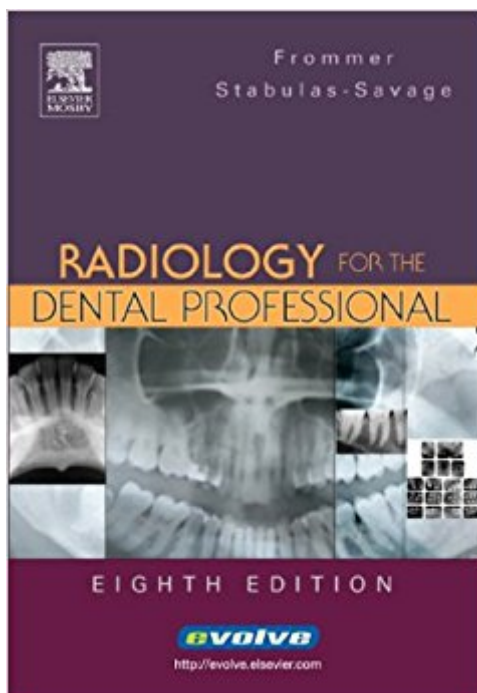

The chapters on digital imaging and newer imaging systems are completely revised to include new cutting-edge imaging modalities such as computed tomography. Chapters are now designed to accommodate one-hour lectures. New clinical photos, added color, and improved line drawings.
