Let me start by confessing that I've read all of this before--on the original BOFH website and on The Register's site for newer stuff. And yet I bought this ebook anyway--it's just that funny. I laughed again as I reread the Bastard's antics in managing his workplace from below (sometimes literally, in the basement...or making personnel changes via elevator shaft...), as well as his conflicts with his assistant, the Pimpily Faced Youth (PFY) and The Boss (any of them). The more you know about IT, the funnier this book can be, but it's not necessary by any means. The Bastard is just this guy, you know? He wants to control his space, and be able to duck out to the pub when work is quiet. It's just that management and users keep making trouble...Sure, the book can get a little repetitive, but most folks are unlikely to read it all in one sitting, as it's a massive text (I read extremely quickly, I was rereading, and it still took a couple of days). The BOFH is not Dilbert--he's lazy, he's

underappreciated, he's frequently asked to help, and that makes him vengeful. Your IT folks have probably read this already. Pick it up and be proactive about workplace health and safety.
