

Going through the tips and practicing all the tests will definitely improve students' test scores significantly. Some of the problems $\tilde{A} \in \hat{A}$ \hat{A}^{TM} complexity is one notch higher than that of actual SAT test problems. So practicing this way will help the students better prepared with more confidence. There are circumstances where the solution could be explained in simpler way. This book assumes that the students are familiar with required math concepts. So without appropriate math fundamentals, an attempt to use this book may discourage the student to continue further. The students who achieved consistently B+ or more in their school math grades will really enjoy working through all the tests. However the students who are below average in their math grades may get disappointed because they need help on some complex problems. For such students McGraw-Hill Education SAT 2015 will help a lot. Gruberâ Â™s Complete SAT Guide is another good book for the students who wanted to review concepts. This is the first time I ever wrote a review, but I felt a need to do it. I bought Dr. Chung's book for my son. I thought it was a bit pricey, but I found it was well worth it. It's really for those wanting to get well into the 700's. My son did all the tips and all the practice questions. The book assumes you have a good foundation. It really helped my son master the hard questions that he was missing. He left the SAT test thinking he had scored 760 at minimum. He ended up scoring 720 and was disappointed, until he realized that the score was still 50 points higher than the first time around without Dr. Chung. The questions and answers are clear. I have read some reviews that there are some errors, but I went through the questions myself and didn't find any errors. I did find one or two instances where I felt a different and simpler strategy would have solved the problem. Overall, I love this book and will treasure it in case my son needs it for the GSAT. It's definitely not for the faint of

heart. I posted this review several months after I bought this book, so I could report on my son's SAT results. My son missed only three math questions to get 720. I highly recommend this book and it's well worth the price.

Dr. Chungs's book provides students with many challenging SAT questions with explanations. I am a teacher and I use his book to teach my SAT preparation class. This is a rare book that challenges every level of student. I recommend it highly.

This book really is the ultimate book for scoring an 800 on the SAT math section. I improved my score by over one hundred points. The real SAT will feel easy after using this book. However, I would only recommend this book to strong math students. If you're weaker in math, start with an easier SAT math prep book geared towards low scorers. Once you've got the fundamentals down, move onto this book to perfect your score.

Dr. John Chung's latest edition of his SAT Math book is better than his last editions and any other SAT Math book out there. He thoroughly explains every topic and his explanations are clear and precise. I really like this book and the practice tests make me confident for the real exam.

For a parent who is starting to worry about SAT preparation, this book should put your mind at ease. I am confident that this book holds every possible variation on SAT math questions that can possibly exist. The book starts out with approximately 50 Tips on how to solve the most frequently asked questions on the SAT Math portions of the test. The questions are challenging, but by the time the test comes around your son or daughter will definitely feel that they have been exposed to every scenario and variation of math topic. My son likes this book because it is straight to the point -- it prepares you for the math you will see on the test.
