

Black and Gold is a pictorial romp through four decades of one of the NHL's great Original Six franchises -a personal history of the Boston Bruins as seen through the lens of Steve Babineau, team photographer for 38 years. Over his long career, Babs, as he is known, has captured over one-third of the history of this storied franchise with his work. He has seen many of the greatest in the organization and has photographed them all for the record: Bobby Orr, John Bucyk, Phil

Esposito, Terry O'Reilly, Ray Bourgue, Cam Neely, Gerry Cheevers, Don Cherry and his Lunchpail Gang, and many more. In this updated edition, Babs and his photo-grapher son Brian have added their best images from the 2010 Winter Classic on New Year's Day at Fenway Park, and from the Bruins' run to the Stanley Cup title in 2011. This new volume also offers a collection of rare behind-the-scenes event photos and an expansion of the photographer's scrapbook. With veteran hockey journalist, broadcaster, and author Rob Simpson, Babs shares his memories and best-loved moments with the team: from growing up a Bruins fan, getting interested in photography and coming to work for the Bs, documenting the team and its players through four decades, and adding a championship ring to his jewelry collection. As well as Babs' perspective on the Bruins -from the stands, the penalty box, the press box, and the arena rafters-Black and Gold features interviews with many former Bruins, coaches, and general managers, peppering the pages with great first-hand stories and anecdotes on what it means to be a Bruin and share in the great tradition of the franchise; and on the hundreds of blueliners, scorers and playmakers, grinders and enforcers, goalies, and coaches that passed through the organization in the four decades that Babs caught on film. Thirty-eight years and some 1,800 games have gone by since Babineau shot his first game back in the 1973-74 season, and he's still counting. Black and Gold is a fitting testament to that great career, and to those who fill its pages. This stunning collection of photographs, magical moments, and commentary from the last four decades will be sure to bring back memories for every Bruins fan who bleeds black and gold.

I was at first a little dissapointed when I received this for a Christmas gift. I was looking for the new book just put out attributed to the 2011 Stanley Cup playoffs. But when I opened this and started going through it all my previous memories of the Bruins started coming through. I have followed the Bruins since the early 1970s. I was 12 when I remember Bobby Orr flying through the air to win the Stanley Cup in May 1970. Steve Babineau and Rob Simpson have put together a very memorable

and excellent book that is a must for any Bruins fan, especially one that has followed them for around 40 years as I have. They have attributed entire chapters to such legends as Bobby Orr, Phil Esposito, John Bucyk, Terry O'Reilly, Ray Bourque and Cam Neely. And he also includes chapters on scorers, defensemen, "masked men", enforcers, grinders and "the Lunch Pail Gang". At the end of the individual chapters are included the statistics of the player/s during their time with the Bruins. The last 2 chapters are attributed to the Winter Classic against the Philadelphia Flyers and the 2011 playoff run. I haven't been able to finish it yet with all the business of the holiday season, but what I have gone through so far has been excellent. Most of the pictures are in vivid color all on glossy paper and it includes some rare photos, such as Bobby Orr and Brad Park together and many more, too many to list. There are pictures of players I forgot played for the Bruins. It is a definite must for any Big Bruins fan. It is an absolutely fantastic book.
