

I literally just discovered that "Wildwood Creek" is book 4 in a series, LOL. I have a habit of doing that (reading books way out of order) - but I think this just speaks to how well "Wildwood Creek" is written, because I didn't have a clue until I came to review it. "Wildwood Creek" is one of the best books I've read in a long time! I'd read a portion of it many moons ago, and only remembered vague details, but the great writing and fascinating plot kept me hooked from page 1. I didn't mind re-reading, and it was wonderful to be kept guessing the entire time. Love, love, love Lisa Wingate's writing, and I can't wait to check out the other books in the series.

First, this is the fourth book in a series, however you will enjoy it if you have read none of the other books because it stands alone. If you have been lucky enough to read the other books, you will enjoy seeing characters from those books showing up as side characters in this one. It's kind of like running into an old friend in a store. Her characters all seem like friends by the time you finish the book, you expect to run into them or to be able to call them. This one is a little different from the others in that it takes place in the same place, but at two different times. You get a historical story and a modern one all at once. I could not put it down, I had to see what happened next. I am really hoping there is another one, because I wonder a lot about what happens to these characters after the story ends. They have become old friends I want to keep up with. I am usually good at figuring out plot twists, but she surprised me in this one. I love it when that happens. This book is one of my new favorites.
