

The sketches, photography and descriptions are outstanding and the color photos are a great help and a big step forward over the previous editions which I am also fortunate to own. Morris has done his research on updating a lot of the taxonomic nomenclature which has changed significantly in past years as better techniques are found to compare species. This volume and the earlier black and white volume became the basis for final classification of several difficult shells in my own book, "Beachcomber Sea Shells of the Caribbean."
