

PHILIPPA FAULKS is an author, ghost writer, freelance editor and journalist. She has written eight books, including the best-selling The Masonic Magician: the Life and Death of Count Cagliostro and his Egyptian Rite (Watkins Publishing, 2008) A Handbook for the Freemason's Wife, The Secrets of Meditation, Henna Magic, Modern Mantras and The Zen Diet ; also included are several other titles I was ghost writer for. She has edited many books in the course of her work as Publishing Manager of a medium sized publishing house.

The book presents a nice balance between the biography of Cagliostro and a discussion of the alchemical and arcane lore (particularly that of ancient Egypt) which resulted in the development of his Egyptian Rite of Freemasonry. The book also demonstrates how the thinking of other mystics and Age of Englightenment philosophers with whom he interacted and studied shaped his own opinions and world view. The book treats the Count with objectivity, leaving it to the reader to form his own opinions as to whether or not the Count was a tragic, misguided charlatan or a philanthropist who sought to aid men and bring them to a higher state of intellectual and moral

purity. The latter part of the book discusses the development of Cagliostro's Egyptian Rite and its Adoptive Grades (for women) and presents a full translation of a manuscript of the three degrees of the Rite held in the Museum of the Grand Lodge of Scotland, followed by an analysis of these degrees by the authors and an interpretation of the symbolic devices utilized in them. A well-written and illustrated book on one of the premier thinkers of the latter 18th century that quickly engages the reader's attention and interest and holds it throughout the reading.

This is a very readable book that tells the story of Count Cagliostro, some historical aspects "new age" thinking, and of the formation of modern Freemasonry and its rituals. I highly recommend this book if you are a Freemason and you want to learn more about the early days of Freemasonry in Europe.

This is a good book. It contains various aspects of the life of Balsamo as a real master of freemasonry who had the knowledge of the sacred science of Egypt (Al-Khem, the ancient Real Art of spiritual development) and Magic. A must have

Departing from the usual biography of Cagliostro, the case for the divorce between Giuseppe Balsamo and Count Cagliostro is presented and argued soundly, though not thoroughly enough to shake the assertion that both were one-in-the-same. Cagliostro's life and life's work are presented with great charity if not clarity in places. The work is clearly an effort to redeem one of history's more colorful and enigmatic figures. The book will appeal to students of masonry, flim-flam, French history, alchemy, occultism, and medicine. The only caveat that should be provided is that the book's approach to the subject matter is unorthodox; the typical portrayal of Cagliostro as charlatan is dismissed in favor of revision.
